

FOUR CORNERS ARTS CENTER
ARTIST CONTRACT

This agreement is made by and between the Four Corners Arts Center and

(The Artist)

The Artist shall execute the work in accordance with the following agreement:

1. The Artist shall be responsible for the complete fabrication, delivery, and installation of the work. Any significant changes in scope, design, or materials from that proposed shall be made in writing and shall require review and approval by the Four Corners Arts Center. The Four Corners Arts Center and the Artist shall agree on a mutually suitable time frame for the installation of the work by mid June. As part of the Four Corners annual arts program, local students are invited to assist in the installation of appropriate work. Artists are encouraged to participate in this program.
2. The Artist warrants that the work is solely the result of the artistic effort of the Artist and does not infringe upon any copyright, is unique and original, and free from any liens.
3. The Four Corners Arts Center shall not assume any responsibility for the maintenance on the work. Unless designed to return to nature, the sculptures shall be fabricated and made of materials that are durable will withstand public interaction. All sites are accessible to the public 24 hours a day, with the exception of times when The Meeting House holds a special event such as a wedding or private party.
4. The Four Corners Arts Center does not carry insurance for the sculptures. Our site is open to the public and unattended at night. Although we have had no vandalism in the past, we cannot guarantee the works. Artists must provide their own insurance if necessary. Because the site is visited by children as well as adults all work must be "kid-proof" without sharp edges or anything that can injure the public. The Artist shall indemnify and hold harmless the Four Corners Arts Center, its agents, and employees. If a work is damaged the artist will be required to repair the work as soon as possible or remove the work from the premises.
5. The Arts Center will provide and install a 4" x 6" weatherproof plaque indentifying the Artist and Title of the work. Also, we will provide each exhibitor a map of the grounds to the public indicating the location of the sculptures and, if applicable, a brief artist statement about the work.
6. The Artist will remove the work from the site between September 8th and September 30th 2009.

The Four Corners Arts Center is still accepting portfolios for consideration for their 2010 outdoor sculpture park until June 28th 2010!

This is the 13th annual exhibit of sculpture at Tiverton Four Corners, an historic village in Rhode Island not far from Newport. Each summer in July and August the Four Corners Arts Center has provided an exhibit of sculptors behind The Meeting House, a popular venue for weddings, private parties, as well as community and arts events. Each summer several thousand people visit Tiverton Four Corners to visit its distinctive shops and art galleries. Please visit www.FourCornersArts.org/sculpture to see past works.

Artist's sculpture portfolios are due by June 28th. Artists will be notified within two weeks if their proposal is accepted. Proposals can be sent by mail or digitally. Please be sure to include measurements, materials and color(s) to be used. Also, artists may submit more than one proposal. If sent by mail artists should include a self addressed envelope for all information to be returned. If proposal is accepted the Arts Center may choose (with permission of course) to keep the information a little longer for PR purposes but, the information will be returned in a timely manner. Please note that all sculptures must be ready for installation by July 9th 2010.

These pieces do not have to be "site specific" though artists are welcome to come and tour the location. Please refer to the website for more information on how to get to the park. Artist should also to note that these sculptures will need to be weather-resistant and child-proof. Please refer to the Artist Contract on the Arts Center website for more specifics. It is also understood that all rights and copyright to the works submitted belong to the artist.
